Malbec Reserva 2007

The Creation:

Composed of 3 Malbec Vineyards from properties owned by Simona Moenaert Winery in Mendoza. "Parcel 56" is 60% of the blend from a vineyard in the Uco Valley (20 year old vines) at 4,300 feet above sea level. This parcel is used for concentration of flavors, deep and intense colors, and density in the structure. "Parcel 430" is 25% of the blend and the vineyard is located in Lujan de Cuyo (60 year old vines). The parcel's main characteristics are used to give the wine an elegant and balanced mouthfeel. Finally, "Parcel 120" is the last piece of this creation with 15% of the blend from another vineyard in Lujá de Cuyo (80 year old vines). This parcel expresses the aromas, complexities and minerality found in the wine.

Aged 8 months in French Oak barrels (First use)

Winemakers Tasting notes:

Dark rich red color with purple tones, balanced notes of red fruits, vanilla and a slightly toasted oak on the palate. Strong and firmly structured with sweet rounded tannins on a lush and lasting finish.
